1 - THE CONCLUSION-HIS PERFECT LOVELINESS! - Perfect and utmost loveliness is found in HIM! All that is lovely of God is found in HIM. All that is lovely in humanity is found in HIM. All that is lovely of earth is found in HIM. All that is lovely in the universe is found in HIM. Every part and every feature of Jesus is ALTOGETHER LOVELY! His character and Person are composed of elements that are faultless. All combine to produce perfect loveliness in ONE WHOLE! Lovely in His birth, in infancy, in boyhood, in manhood, in mourning, in rejoicing, in speech and silence. Lovely as Prophet, Priest, King, Shepherd, Servant, Son and Saviour! There is nothing unlovely in HIM! Nothing to be removed or altered, nothing to conceal of failure. Nothing to disguise, nothing to excuse. Job, most patient, yet cursed the day of his birth (Job 3:1,2). David, man after God's heart, commits adultery and murder (2 Sam.11). Peter, noted for his boldness and courage, sins by cowardice and later fears the circumcision (Lu.22:54-62;Gal.2:11,12). John, famed for love, desired fire to fall from heaven on others (Lu.9:54). The outstanding sins of eminent saints have been contrary to their general character; sad failure is seen in those graces for which they were distinguished. Why? God reveals the unloveliness of the loveliest men to keep us from looking at any other Person on earth, or in heaven, but upon HIM WHO ALONE IS THE CHIEFEST OF TEN THOUSAND AND ALTOGETHER LOVELY! - in order for us to say, "THIS is MY beloved and THIS is MY friend!".
