## "THE IMPECCABLE CHRIST"

## Beloved of the Lord:

Have you ever deeply meditated upon the Person of Christ as the only sinless man that ever lived? He <u>wants</u> to know what you think of Him - Matt. 22:42. Meditate deeply on the following facts concerning His life on earth:

- HIS SINLESS BIRTH Luke 1:35. Conceived, not by human conception, but by the Holy Ghost and the Power of the Highest, He was born and called "that Holy Thing", the only sinless Babe entering this world. Not so, the rest of us see Psalms 51:5; 1 Kings 8:46. He possessed a sinless nature! Wonderful Babe of Bethlehem!
- 2- HIS SINLESS YOUTH Luke 2:52. In all the years of obscurity at Nazareth, He continued sinless and holy, growing in wisdom, in stature, and in favor with God and Man." Mentally, physically and spiritually He developed, so that as he entered into the service of His public ministry, the Father confirmed his sinlessness "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" Matt. 3:17.
- 3. HIS SINLESS MINISTRY Revealed -
  - A- By his Obedience "I do always those things that please my Father" John 8:29
  - B- By His Character "Which of you convinceth Me of Sin John 8:46. His enemies were constantly seeking to cause Him to sin, as did the Devil also Matt. 4:1-11. He proved that He was "holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners Heb. 7:26.
  - C- By His Leadership Note John 1:36-39; John 1:43; His disciples followed Him Matt. 19:28; Luke 5:11; Matt. 9:9. They followed a sinless leader: for he taught them to pray "forgive us our sins" Luke 11:4 but He Himself never had to pray this! He is still the perfect Leader "the leader and completer of faith" for us today Heb. 11:2 J.N.D. Trans. leading us to glory!
- 4- HIS SINLESS DEATH John 19:30
  - A- His unshaken confidence in His personal righteousness is proved in Matt. 27:46.
  - B- The only man who rightfully could say to God "WHY ME?" In Him was no sin 1 John 3:5 He did no sin 1 Pet.2:22; He knows no sin 2 Cor 5:21 But -
  - C- He bore "Our Sins" 1 Pet 2:24; "Our transgressions" "Our iniquities" Isa. 53:5,6 "Behold! a spotless victim dies, my surety on the tree The Lamb of God the sacrifice He gave Himself for Me!"
  - D- I was <u>The Filthy Man</u> of Psalm 14. Christ was <u>The Forsaken Man</u> of Psalm 22. Now, I am <u>The Forgiven Man</u> of Psalm 32.
- 5. <u>HIS SINLESS RESURRECTION</u> Acts 2:24 "Whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death: <u>Because</u> it was not possible that He should be holden of it". Now, by Faith, I am identified with Him! Rom 6:4,5. Soon, I shall "be like Him" 1 John 3:2. Hallelujah! What a Savior! Rev. 22:20 "MY MEDITATION OF HIM SHALL BE SWEET" Psalms. 104:34
